
REQUESTING YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT

The Minnesota Secretary of State has made obtaining your absentee ballot easy by teaming up with the Overseas Vote Foundation (OVF). OVF is a nongovernmental, nonpartisan, charitable organization. In order to request your absentee ballot, go to the following link:

Select to submit your application online (ID is required) or submit your application by email, mail, or fax. Enter your personal information into the boxes and Standard Form 76a, Registration and Absentee Ballot Request, will be completed with your information. Once the form is completed, submit your application online or print off the form and sign it. Once it is signed you will either need to mail or fax it back to the Minnesota Secretary of State at:

If you are not able to fill out the absentee registration, your spouse, sibling, parent, or child over the age of 18 may do so for you.
